

TENDER-LEAF FORAGE TEFF

SUMMER ANNUAL HAY & FORAGE

TENDER-LEAF FORAGE TEFF is a warm-season summer annual forage grass that germinates quickly and can be harvested multiple times throughout the growing season. Expect high yields and excellent forage quality that is ideal for horses and other livestock.

TENDER-LEAF FORAGE TEFF is planted when soil temperatures are 65 degrees and above, and when the dangers of frost are gone. Plant 1/8-1/4 inch into a seedbed that is firm and hard enough to bounce a basketball. The first cutting is taken 45-50 days after planting, with subsequent cuttings at 30-day intervals. Cut in the pre-boot / early-boot stage for maximum yields and forage quality. Leave 4 inches of stubble to promote its vigorous regrowth cycle.

TENDER-LEAF FORAGE TEFF can also be inter-seeded into winter-killed or thinning alfalfa stands to gain emergency forage yields.
